We Believe in baptism with the Holy Spirit and with fire, to be empowered to go out and share the good news without condemnation.

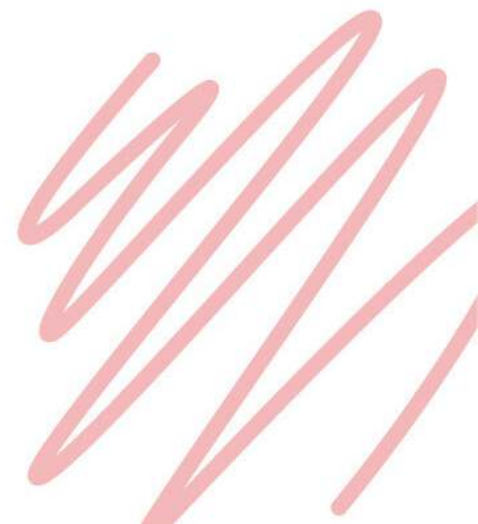
The following signs of healing, deliverance, and to raise death people shall follow us as the Holy Spirit Guides us.

We believe in Jesus' finished work at the cross. We can't gain anything with "our work". We shall walk in readymade duties.

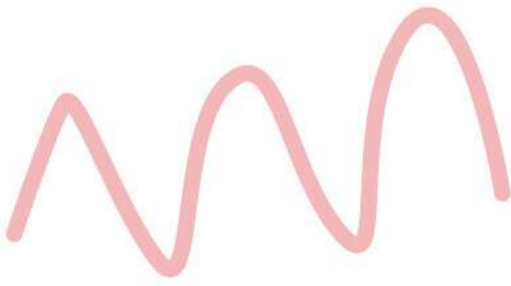
Jesus is our provider, not men.

The Bible is not a product of human wisdom or imagination but a result of God's direct communication with humanity through chosen individuals.

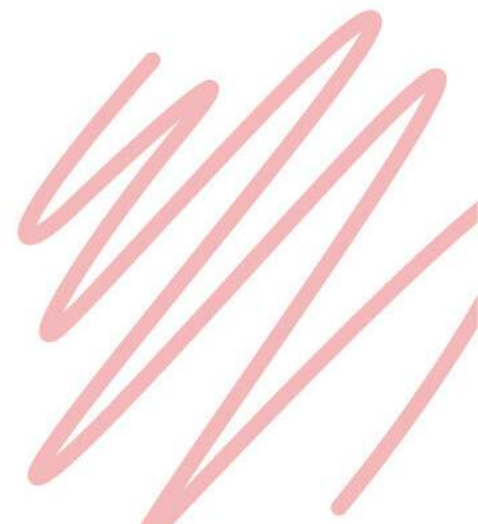
4.3 The apostle Paul

Scholars and theologians have dedicated their lives to ensuring the accuracy and integrity of the Bible's message, allowing us to rely on its authority.

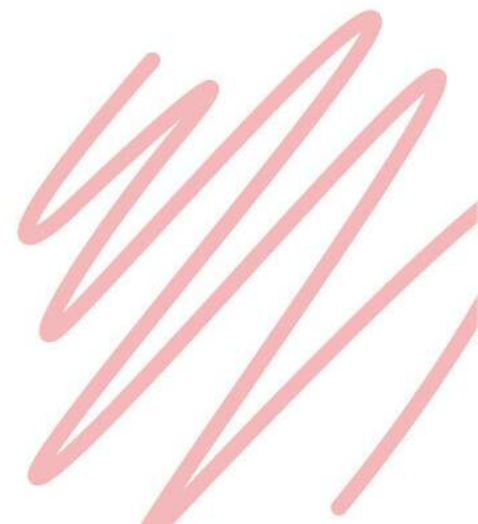

In this article, we will explore the concept of the triune God, and examine the biblical foundations and the implications it holds for our understanding of God's nature and our relationship with Him.

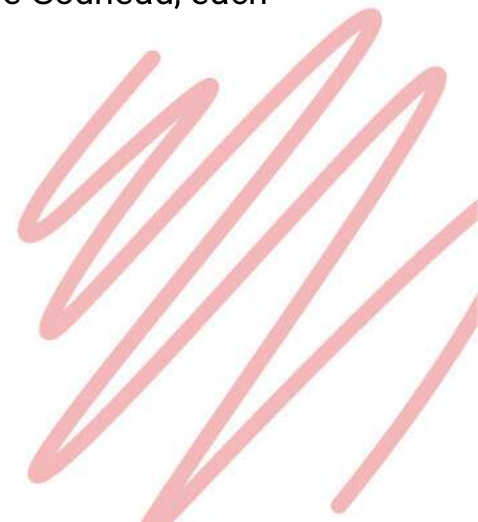
5.2 The Biblical Foundation:

Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever you had formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God."

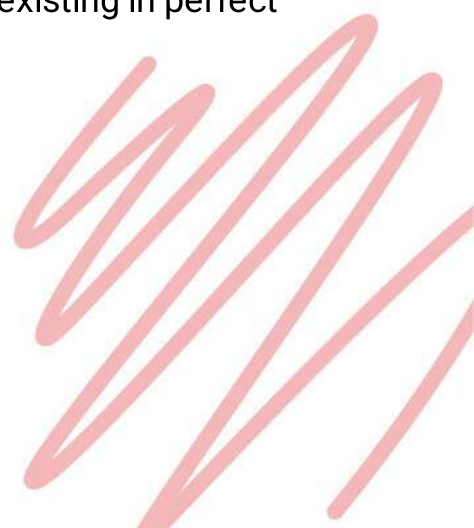
This passage reinforces the idea that God exists beyond the confines of time and space, existing before all creation.

Secondly, recognizing the triune nature of God helps us grasp the depth and breadth of His love and salvation.

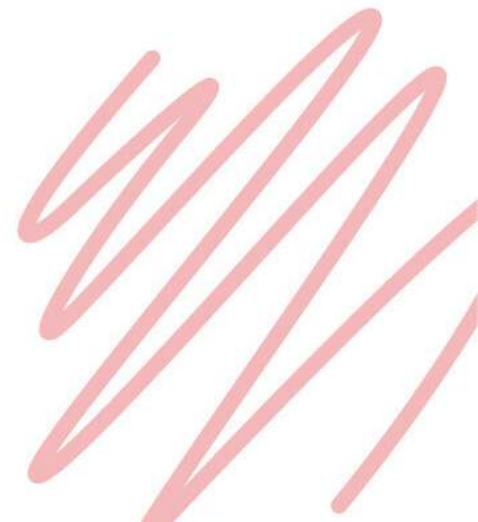
Through Jesus Christ, we experience the love of the Father and are empowered by the Holy Spirit to live a life that honours Him.

The belief in the triune God is a foundational doctrine of Christianity, revealing the complexity and beauty of God's nature.





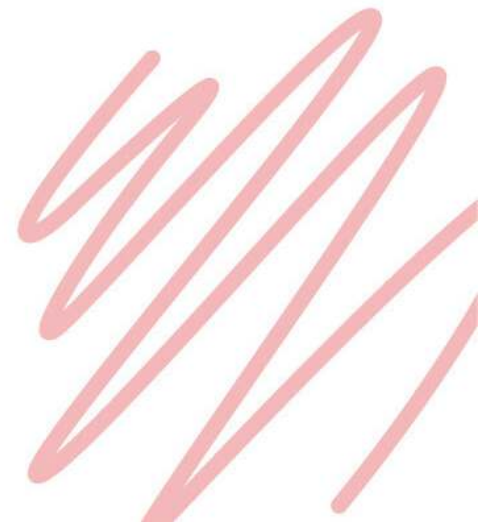
